On the Road To a Brand New Home with the PetPoint Transfer Network



Does your organization have too many retrievers and not enough terriers?

The PetPoint Transfer Network (PPTN) levels this playing field by allowing organizations to:

- ✓ Collaborate with neighboring organizations to connect the right animals with the right adopters.
- ✓ Setup potential Source and Destination transfer organizations, each with different rules for what types of animals can or cannot be viewed or requested.
- ✓ Improve adopter options by bringing breed diversity to your animal population.
- ✓ Save hours of time spent on transfers – animals within the PPTN can be quickly & easily transferred electronically via the Transfer Module available in all three versions of the PetPoint Data Management System.

How it Works:

The PetPoint Transfer Network works as a hub between organizations. Through one easy-to-use interface, Source organizations can publish their available animals and manage requests for them, while Destination organizations can search for and request transfers.

Source organizations (those with animals available for transfer), can:

- Automatically publish a list of animals to the PPTN based on an animal's stage (choices are Viewable, Available, and Critical Need).
- Add animal pictures and transfer memos to provide a comprehensive record for Destination organizations to review prior to transfer.
- Setup a directory of approved Destination organizations that can place requests.
- Approve or decline requests for transfer, as well as manage transfer logistics, such as pickup date/time.

Destination organizations (those seeking animals available to transfer), can:





- Search for animals within the PPTN that are available for transfer, by Species, Breed, Primary Color Group, Age, and Asilomar Status.
- Gain important information about animals before a transfer is made.
- Place requests for specific animals (and withdraw requests if needed).
- Manage transfer logistics, such as pickup date/time.
